2. I will not give out personal information such as my last name, address, phone number, or the name and address of my school without my teacher's permission.
3. I will treat all hardware responsibly and will make every effort to leave computers ready for the next person by quitting all applications and by removing from the desktop any files which I have placed there.
4. I will not eat, drink or bring magnets to the computer labs or near our classroom computers.
5. I will not duplicate or download copyrighted software to Lovett's computer's.

I understand the following are not allowed:

1. sending or displaying unkind, obscene, or offensive messages or pictures
2. using another person's password
3. trespassing in another person's folder, work, or files
4. wasting limited resources such as printing multiple copies unnecessarily
5. downloading viruses or hacking programs that can cause problems with our system software
6. using electronic resources without giving credit to the source of the material

My child and I have read the Technology Code of Conduct and the Technology Use Agreement and have discussed appropriate behavior concerning use of technology at school and home. By signing this agreement, we are accepting responsibility for our behavior in the use of technology at The Lovett School.
