Open FileMaker Pro

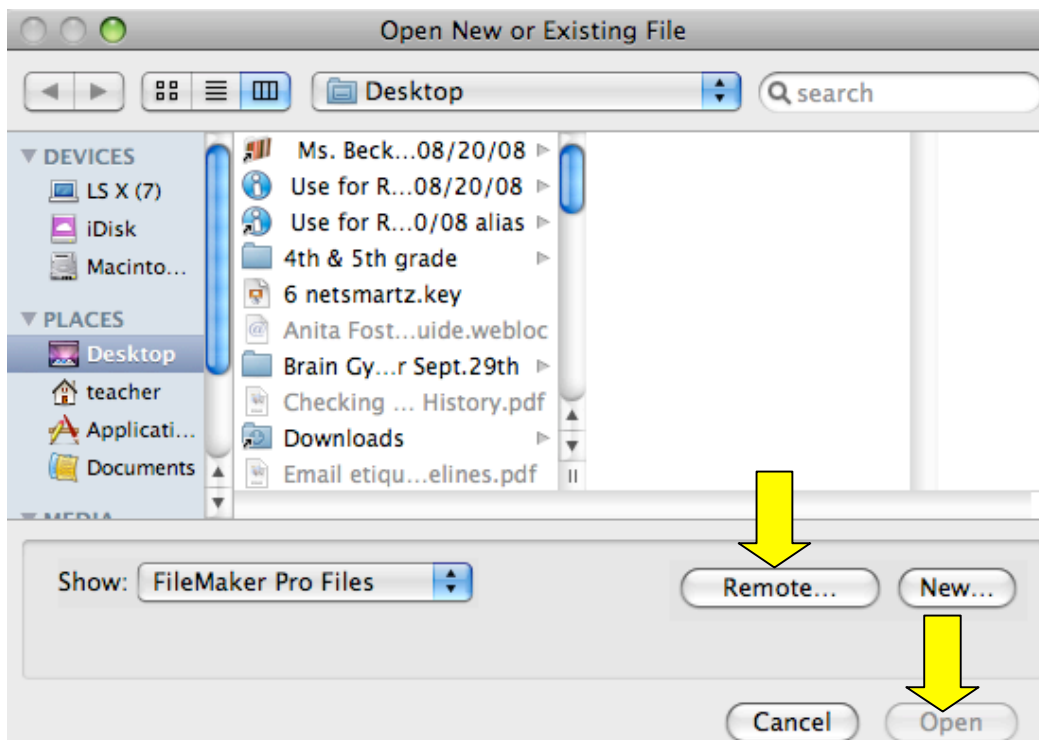
(from the loading dock or [Applications folder found inside the Macintosh HD](#)), short cut command to get to the Applications folder is **SHIFT/Command/A**

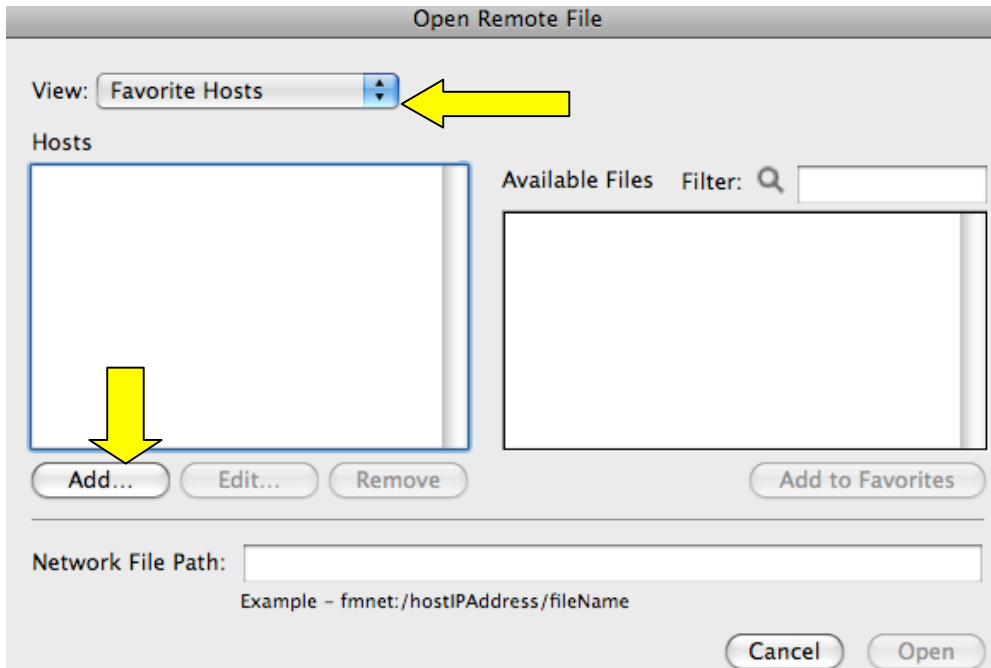
The icon should look like this:

Click on **Remote button...** then click on the **Open button** as shown below. If the remote button isn't visible click on **File** from the menubar and drag down to **Open Remote...**

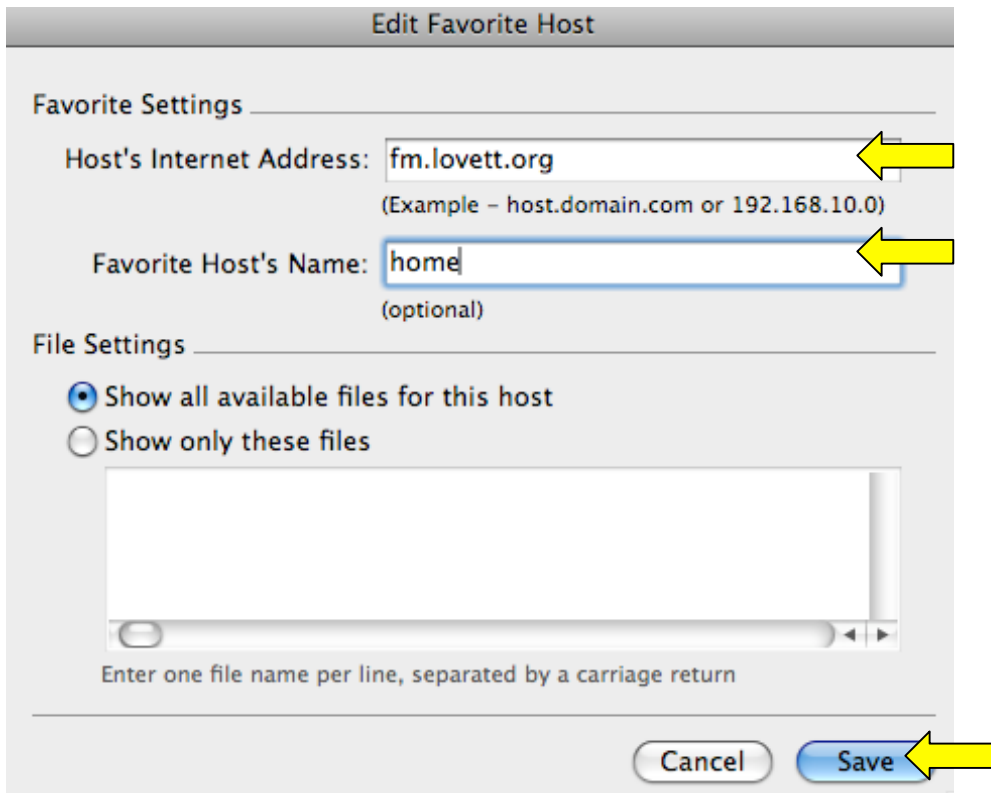


Now you'll see the screen below. You should click on the **Add button...** the View: should be on Favorite Hosts

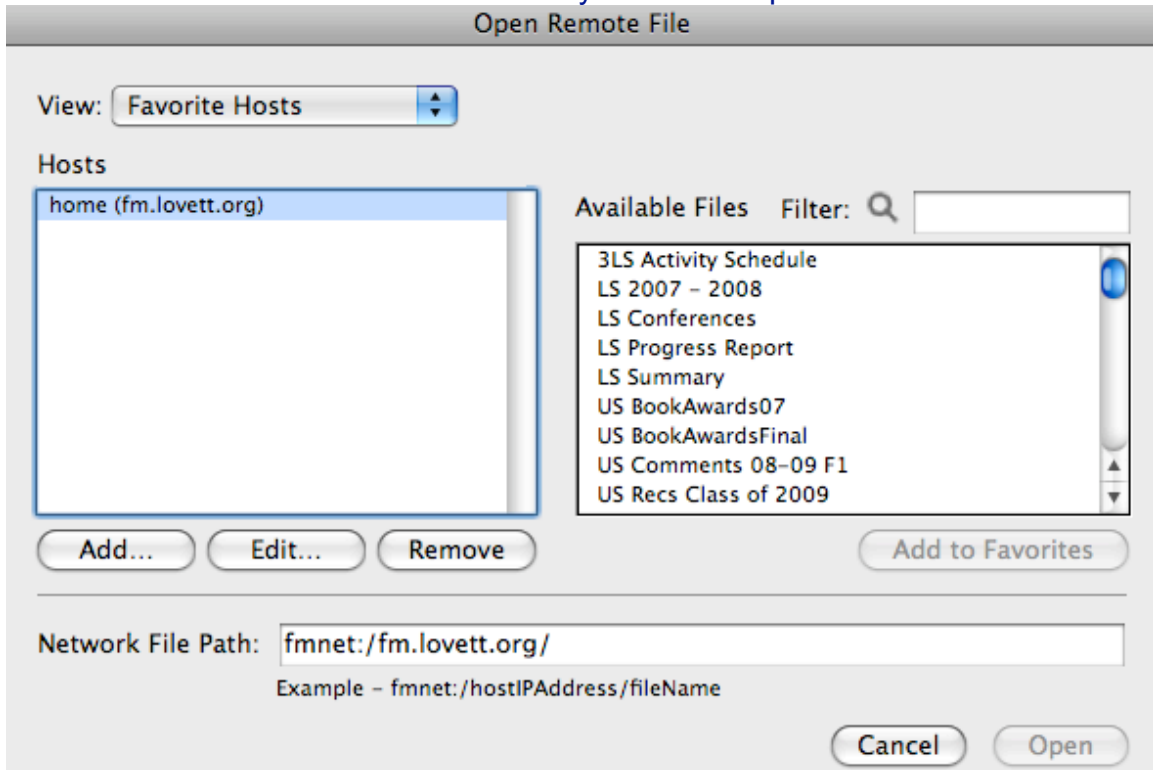

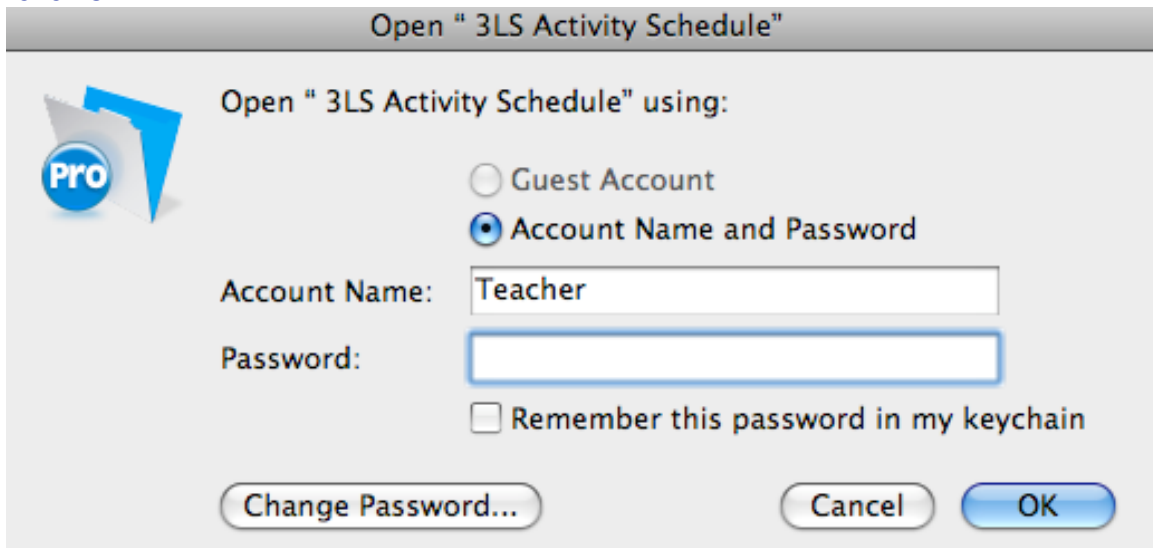
After you click on the save button you should see the following screen.
